### Investment Objective

The portfolio aims to provide a return in excess of Money Market portfolios and is suitable for investors that are seeking relatively high levels of income, minimised volatility and a low risk of capital loss.

### Investment Policy

This income generating strategy with the aim of achieving a high level of sustainable income and stability of capital invested. The strategy will be managed in compliance with prudential investment guidelines for retirement funds in South Africa to the extent allowed for by the Act, subject to a maximum equity of 10% of the strategy's net asset value. Investments to be acquired for the strategy may include equity securities, property securities, property related securities, interest bearing securities, non-equity securities, notes, money market instruments, preference shares and assets in liquid form. The strategy may invest in participatory interests and other forms of participation in portfolios of collective investment schemes, registered in South Africa and other similar schemes operated in territories with a regulatory environment which is to the satisfaction of the manager and trustee of a sufficient standard to provide investor protection at least equivalent to that in South Africa. The strategy may from time to time invest in listed and unlisted financial instruments, in order to achieve the strategy's investment objective. The manager may also include forward currency, interest rate and exchange rate swap transactions for efficient strategy management purposes.

The portfolio is likely to suit investors that looking for:

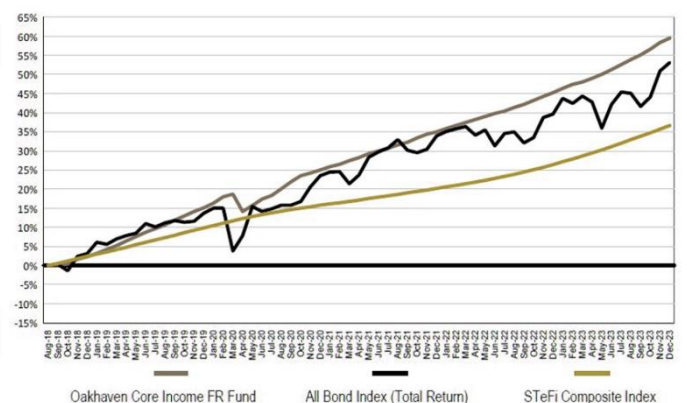

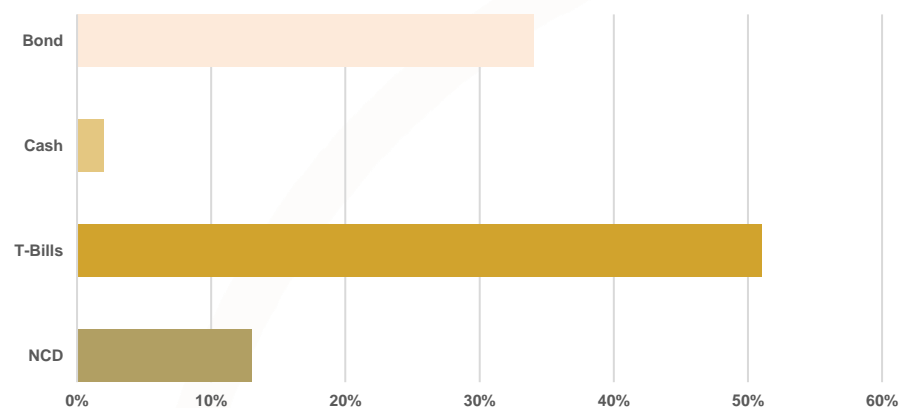
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### Market Commentary

The nominal yield curve bull steeped during December as investors began pricing the possibility of policy rate cuts in the US and SA over the coming quarters. The increased inflation risk associated with such rate cuts and lingering fiscal concerns also explained why long-dated bonds underperformed the rest of the nominal curve. Consequently, break-even yields widened, and linkers (+2.2%) outperformed nominals (1.5%) and equities (+1.4%) on the month. That all said, for the year as a whole, the nominal curve bear steepened in response to tighter monetary policy as well as heightened inflation and fiscal risks. This in turn, ensured that nominals (+9.7%) and linkers (+7.0%) underperformed equities (+20.7%) and cash (10.6%) during 2023

### Market Commentary

**Interest Rate Risk:** There is an inverse relationship between the values of bonds and other debt securities and the change in interest rates. ### Market Commentary

**Net Asset Value (NAV):** Means net asset value, which is the total market value of all assets in a portfolio including any income accruals and less and deductible expenses such as audit fees, brokerage and service fees.

**Annualised Return:** Is the weighted average compound growth rate over the performance period measured

**Highest & Lowest Return:** He highest and lowest rolling twelve-month performance of the portfolio since inception.

**Total Expense Ratio (TER):** Reflects the percentage of the average Net Asset Value (NAV) of the portfolio that was incurred as charges, levies and fees related to the management of the portfolio. A higher TER does not necessarily imply a poor return, nor does a low TER imply a good return. The current TER cannot be regarded as an indication of future TER's.

**Transaction Costs (TC):** Is the percentage of the value of the Fund incurred as costs relating to the buying and selling of the Fund's underlying assets. Transaction costs are a necessary cost in administering the Fund and impacts Fund returns.

**Total Investment Charge (TIC):** Should not be considered in isolation as returns may be impacted by many other factors over time including market returns, the type of Fund, investment decisions of the investment manager.

**Total Investment Charges (TIC%):** =TER (%) + TC (%): The Total Investment Charges (TIC), the TER + the TC, is the percentage of the net asset value of the class of the Financial Product incurred as costs relating to the investment of the Financial Product. It should be noted that a TIC is the sum of two calculated ratios (TER+TC)

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### Glossary

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<b>Standard Deviation:</b>	The deviation of the return of the portfolio relative to its average
<b>Downside Deviation:</b>	Disparity of returns below the average return of the portfolio
<b>Drawdown:</b>	The greatest peak to trough loss until a new peak is reached
<b>Sharpe Ratio:</b>	The ratio of excess return over the risk-free rate divided by the total volatility of the portfolio.
<b>Sortino Ratio:</b>	The ratio of excess return over the risk-free rate divided by the downside deviation of the portfolio.
<b>MTD:</b>	Month to date return.



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
